## Come to Bethel's Regular Scheduled Voters Assembly Sunday, November 15, 2020

We will hold our Fall Voters Assembly on **Sunday, November 15, 2020 starting at 2:00 PM.** We will receive updates from each of our boards.

The Church Council will present the Proposed 2021 Budget. Then we will vote on it.

Nursery/Child Care will be provided for this meeting.





**The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod is made up of some 35 districts**, the state of Texas stands as its own. We are 400+ congregations served by a central office in Austin and deployed pastors and DCEs serving as full and part time workers, several dozen specifically to serve us in the “local church.”

**Every three years our entire Texas District gathers “in convention”** to consider mission work, to elect officers & boards of mission and ministry, and appoint Circuit Visitors. All of this is a wonderful opportunity to fellowship, but it is also quite a bit of work. There are a number of ways you may contribute to this process if you are interested.

**Bethel will need a layman or laywoman to serve as our voting delegate** in San Marcos next June. Costs of travel and meals [*within reason*] are covered.

**As well, and our District will have numerous elected positions which will need filled.** If you know a pastor, professional worker, or layperson who might serve in one of the dozens of mission and ministry areas where are District is involved, you have the opportunity to bring them as a nomination to our congregation.

**And finally our local area, from Franklin to Brenham to Anderson will need a new Circuit Visitor.** The CV serves as “head pastor/bishop” of our local congregations, assisting them in the Call process, coaching and counseling our professional workers, and serving as the sounding board when conflict arises. While Pastor Gruhn has served us for the past three years, another area pastor will need to be nominated and elected at the “Circuit Forum” in the winter of 2021. Brother Gruhn has declined to continue, as he wishes to retire for the third time! If you know of an area pastor who might fittingly serve in this position, you also have the opportunity to nominate them to our congregation.

**As you can see, there are dozens of different of ways you might serve within the Texas District, LC-MS.** If you would like more information or if you have thoughts about who might serve well, please talk with Pastor Bard who can point you in the proper direction.

Our congregation is very blessed to be within our Texas LC-MS. We have terrific District leaders and **a very bold mission of 500 new “communities” within the next 16 years.** May our Lord bless us as we meet together next June. +

## Do you remember the Small

**Catechism?** Many of us were made to memorize the catechism (or at least part of it) during our Confirmation classes. Some of us might have even suffered through a public examination over its contents.

How much do you remember? Say it with me: "I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to Him..." Can you finish? Do you remember where that is found? (It's in Luther's explanation of the Third Article of the Apostles' Creed.)

It's time to return. Luther wrote the Small Catechism for the instruction of laypeople. Luther intended the Small Catechism to be used at church and in the home to instruct children in the faith and to reinforce the faith in the hearts and minds of adults.


May this year's anniversary of the Reformation be a time when we return to the Word and Sacraments, when we

turn to Christ and His love. It's *still* all about Jesus. There is no better time than now to review the catechism.

Read it for yourself. Refresh the theology in your mind. Pray the catechism daily. Memorize it.

But even more, teach it. If you are a parent, teach it to your children. As you have opportunity, share it with your friends and peers.

The catechism teaches the fundamentals of the Christian faith: the Ten Commandments, the Lord's Prayer, the Apostles' Creed, the Sacrament of Baptism, the Sacrament of the Altar and the Office of the Keys and Confession. This small book is well worth your time and study. We have Luther's Small Catechism in the church office, if you would like to purchase one.




