

## Fun Family Wednesdays


**Our last night** for Fun Family Wednesdays this season is May 8th. On the Menu we have Cheeseburger sliders, chips, coleslaw, fruit.



We are starting to collect auction items, and we need your help! This day is only successful because of the generous outpouring of gifts we receive through auction item donations!


